CITATION OF AUTHORITY

Title 18 USC 1509 OBSTRUCTION OF COURT ORDER

Whoever, by threats or force, willfully prevents, obstructs, impedes, or interferes with or willfully attempts to prevent, obstruct, or impede, or interfere with, the due exercise of rights or the performance of duties under any order, judgment, or decree of a court of the United States, shall be fined under this title or imprisoned nor more than one year, or both. No Injunctive or other civil relief against the conduct made by this section shall be denied on ground that such conduct is a crime.

Title 18 U.S. Code § 2384 - Seditious conspiracy

If two or more persons in any State or Territory, or in any place subject to the jurisdiction of the United States, conspire to overthrow, put down, or to destroy by force the Government of the United States, or to levy war against them, or to oppose by force the authority thereof, or by force to prevent, hinder, or delay the execution of any law of the United States, or by force to seize, take, or possess any property of the United States contrary to the authority thereof, they shall each be fined under this title or imprisoned not more than twenty years, or both.

Title 18 USC 913 Impersonator Making Arrest

Whoever falsely represents himself to be an officer, agent, or employee of the United States, and in such assumed character arrests or detains any person or in any manner searches the person, buildings, or other property of any person, shall be fined under property of any person, shall be fined under this title or imprisoned not more than three years, or both







YOUR RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES UNDER THE SOCIAL SECURITY ACT

TITLE 42 USC 423 (d)(5)(b) Disability insurance benefit payments. There are 6 authorized protocols where claimants for SSI or SSID can engage in legal proceedings for application of benefits which include:

- 1. SSI application and initial review.
- 2. Reconsideration.
- 3. Administrative law Judge Review.
- 4. Appeals Council.
- Commissioners Final Determination: which if no reviewed by a USDC becomes rinal and cannot be overturned or modified.
- Title 42 USC 405 (G)(h) Judicial Review provides for USDC review of Commissioners final determination.
- Title 42 USC 42 USC 407 Assignment of Benefits provides that your benefits cannot be garnished or seized and any person, group, or organization attempting to do so or should be reported to Social Security Inspector General 1-800-269-0271.
- Any person attempting to vend, dispense, or practice social security law or other law without being a member of the Federal Bar Association or permission of a US Magistrate should be reported to US Attorney's office for investigation of Title 18 USC 402 Contempt or Title 18 USC 913 Impersonator Making Arrest
